

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING A PSYCHOEDUCATIONAL ASSESSMENT

CAREGIVER INTERVIEW 1 HOUR



The psychologist meets with caregivers to obtain important background information and discuss their concerns.

FACE-TO-FACE TESTING 6-9 HOURS



The child or adolescent meets with the examiner for testing in a one-to-one setting. Different standardized tests are administered depending on the presenting problems.

QUESTIONNAIRES



Parents and teachers complete questionnaire measures covering developmental history, social-emotional functioning, attention and concentration skills, executive functioning skills and/or adaptive functioning skills.

FEEDBACK SESSION & REPORT 1 HOUR FOR FEEDBACK; 3 HOURS FOR SCORING AND REPORT WRITING



A comprehensive report is shared with parents during a feedback session. Results from the assessment are reviewed and recommendations are discussed. An older child or adolescent can also participate in this session.
